Chapman has written an extensive range of books focusing on *The 5 Love Languages*. Be sure to check out all his titles. Opportunities to show your love to your distance family are all too brief. Once you understand the love language principles it will help you appreciate how *you* like to be loved but more importantly how each member of your family likes to be loved. For example, don't waste money sending endless presents to a person who isn't a 'Gifts Love Language' person. To a certain degree presents are wasted on them. In contrast, be sure to give a 'Quality Time Love Language' family member your undivided attention, without distractions, whenever you call. These are easy habits to embrace and incredibly effective. This is one of the most powerful, incredibly useful books I have ever read.
